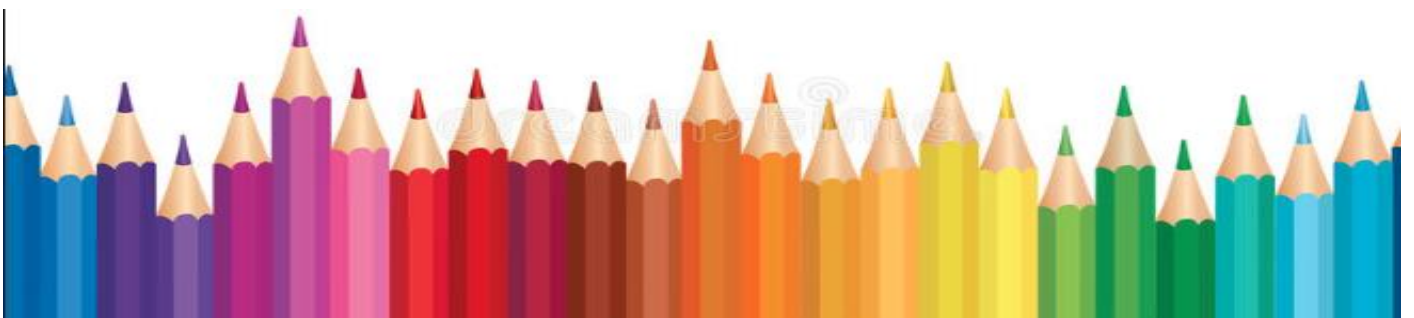

Phonics - All week

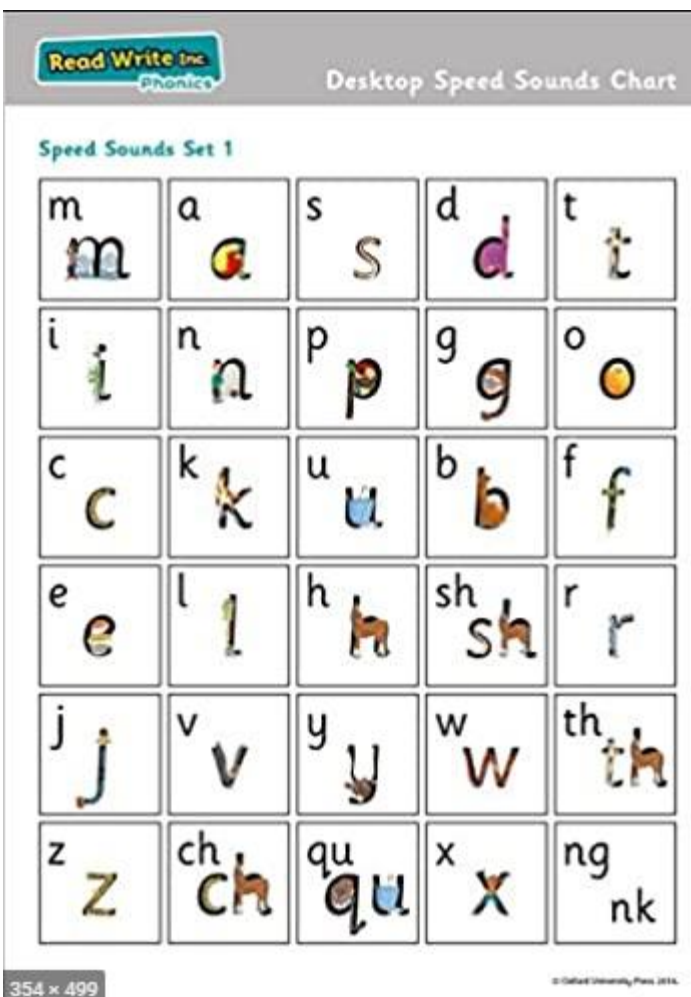
Daily speed sound - complete daily to remind yourself of sounds we have covered in phonics. These are live everyday

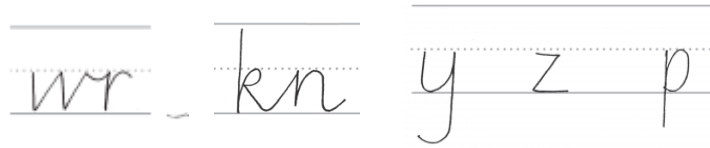

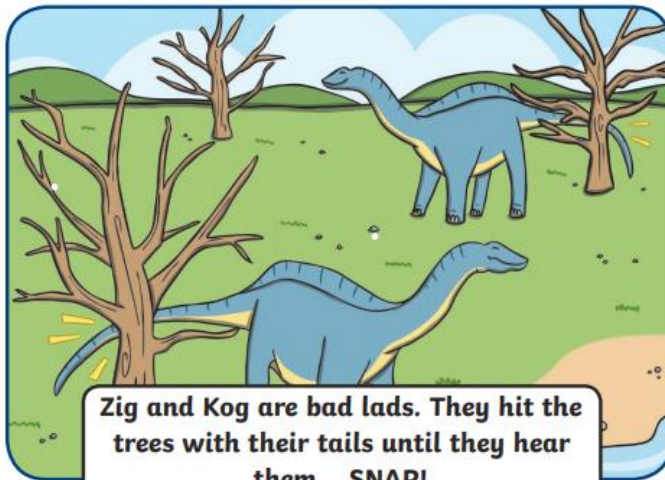
