



Live Lesson Expectations for Parents

- From the second week of lockdown (w.b.11.01.21), we will be delivering three live lessons per class for years 1 to 6. This will be a combination of teaching, explanation and instruction and tasks and this will be reviewed weekly. Each of the Zoom lessons will have a unique link. You will find the link on Google Classroom under that day's work (**by 8.45am each morning**). Simply click on the link at the correct time. The links will be changed daily as the teachers schedule the lessons.
- All lessons will be recorded and saved onto Google Classroom under that day's work. Please allow teachers time to upload the video to Google Classroom. You will then be able to access it at any time of the day.
- At the end of the week, the videos will be archived but will still be accessible.
- Nursery and Reception staff will deliver one live lesson a day to start with and will also continue with pre-recorded sessions. The link to the zoom session will be sent via the memo section of Tapestry. Details of these sessions including timings will also be sent via the memo section.
- Children (years 1- 6) in the live lessons can ask any questions through the Zoom chat or afterwards they can ask these questions on Google Classroom on the stream.
- After the teaching session on the Zoom link, the children are given an opportunity to ask questions directly onto Google Classroom via the Class Stream so that questions and feedback is manageable and effective.
- For Early Years, parents and children can ask questions via the normal method of comments and observation uploads as they currently do with home learning.

Please note: If a teacher has a prior commitment (e.g training or a meeting) the teacher will upload a recorded video instead of a live lesson which can be watched at the allotted time or when convenient.

Daily Timetable for live lessons:

If siblings have lessons at a similar time, please keep in mind that the sessions are recorded and then uploaded onto Google Classroom as soon as possible. The lessons can then be watched at any time thereafter.
