What Can You Do?

- Explore together ask your children what they do and what sites that they like to visit. Maybe ask them to show you how to play a particular game or use a particular app.
- **Encourage** children to use their tech devices in communal areas such as the lounge or kitchen so that you can keep an eye on what they are doing and share in their enjoyment.
- Agree boundaries so that children are clear what they can and can't do online.
- Talk to the school about any new games that you are unfamiliar with or any e-safety concerns that you have.
- Install parental controls on your broadband.
