



Dear Parents and Carers

Please see a summary of our Covid safety arrangements below to support your children's return in September:

#### Arrangements for children

- We ask that you arrive promptly at your allotted arrival and pick up time to avoid congestion at the gate. (Yr 5-6: 8.35am, Yr 3-4: 8.40am, Yr 1-2: 8.45am Reception: 8.50am)
- Children will be asked to wash their hands when they arrive at school and regularly throughout the day
- They will be taught in regular class sizes and will mix only within the maximum 2- year group bubbles (Nursery and Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4, Year 5 and 6)
- In class, children will be seated in rows facing forward to avoid face to face contact
- They will be encouraged to maintain 1m + social distance and not to touch adults – the guidance recognises that young children and those with complex needs may not be able to manage this
- All children are expected to be in full school uniform and should bring their PE kit in a named PE bag, which can remain at school for the half-term
- All children to bring their book bag which should include their reading book and reading record book and a named water bottle
- If children are bringing lunch from home they must have a plastic lunch box (named) which can be easily wiped down
- Years 6 can bring their mobile phones and these will be kept at the office.
- Children in KS2 can continue to bring in equipment from home but will not be sharing equipment
- School dinners will be provided as usual but in disposable, recyclable containers
- Please avoid gathering outside the school gates or on the school playground once you have collected your child/children.
- We will continue to operate a one-way system for entry and exit.

#### Extended Provision

- Breakfast Club will resume from 7th September 2020 – this will be held in the Hall which will be zoned (Years 1 and 2; Years 3 and 4; Years 5 and 6 –Breakfast club must be booked and the entrance will be via the usual KS2 door.
- After School Club will be resuming from 7th Sept 2020 for Years R – 6 and places must be booked in advance
- After School Club will be £6 for shorter session (4.30pm) and £15 for a long session(6pm)
- Numbers for After School Club will be limited to 20 pupils per group (Years 1 and 2; Years 3 and 4; Years 5 and 6) and must be pre-booked

#### Trips and clubs

- The guidance does not currently permit residential trips during the autumn term.
- Only trips within the local area, which pupils can walk to, are permitted.
- If a trip has already been booked, then further information will follow.
- After school teacher lead clubs and outside provider clubs, will not run and this will be reviewed at half term.
