

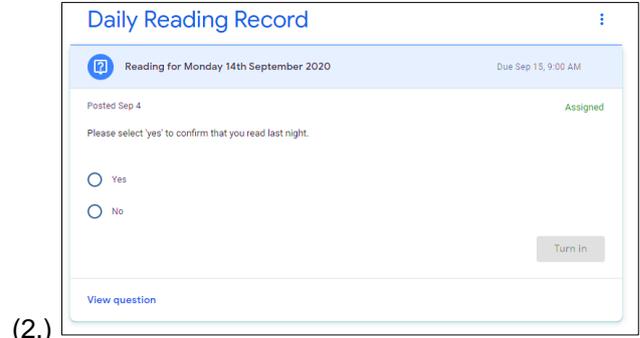
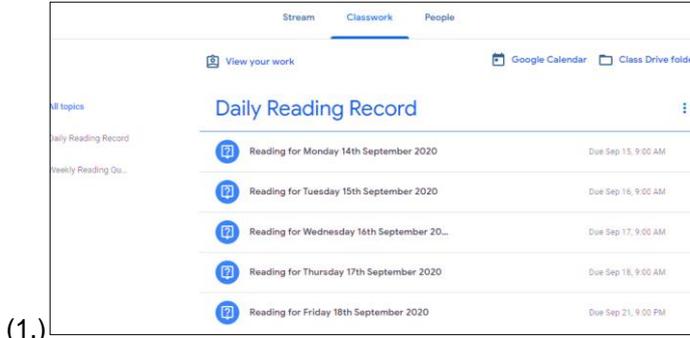
Home Learning Guide

As already outlined, reading records are moving to Google Classroom this term. Every day, after your child has read, we now ask that you login to Google Classroom (using your child's login details).

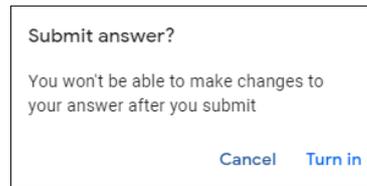
1. Having logged in to Google Classroom and accessed your child's class, you will see the following screen (for your child's class). Click on the 'classwork' option:

You will then see the screen below. Select and click on the day's date.

2. You should then select and click 'yes' to confirm that your child has read:

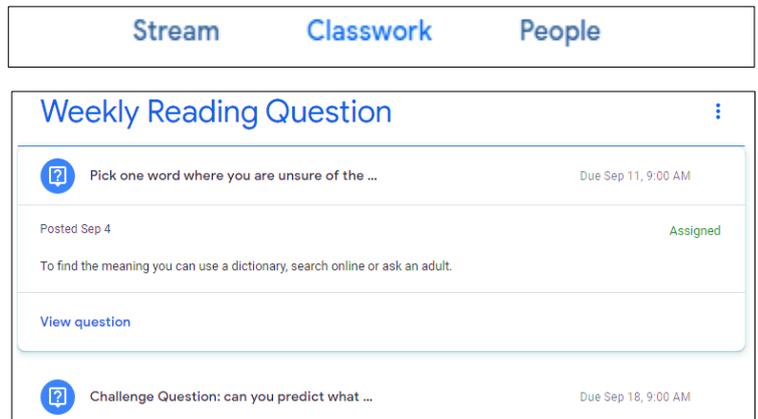


3. To confirm your selection, press the blue 'Turn in' button as shown below:

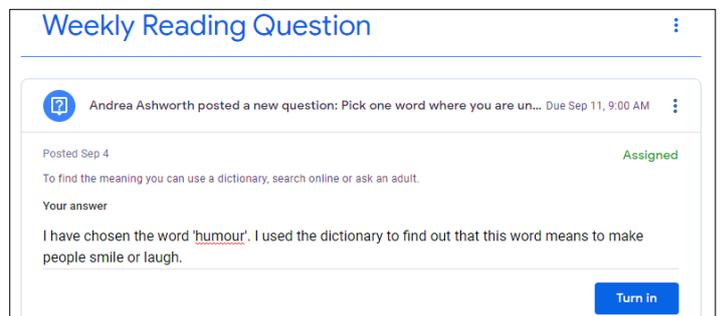
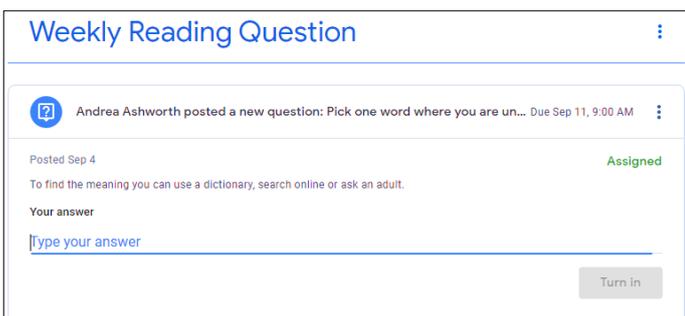


4. You have now completed your child's reading record entry and your child's teacher will be able to see that they have read.

In addition, your child will be set a weekly question about the book they are reading. You will find this as shown:



5. Select the question. We would encourage your child to answer the question by typing this into Google Classroom and 'turning in' as shown below. However, Teacher's will be discussing pupil's answers to these question in lesson time every Friday should your child be unable to write their answer on Google Classroom.



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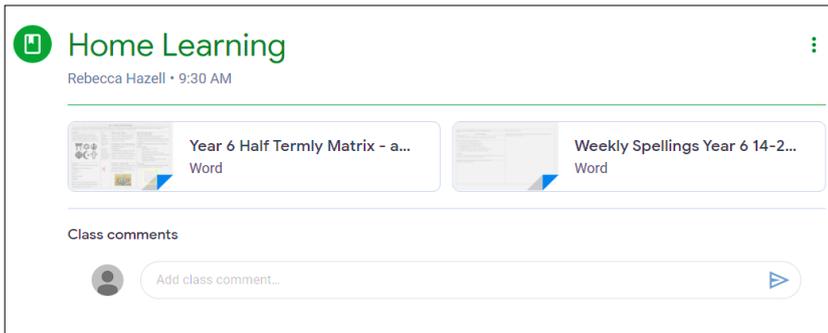
In most cases, there will be an additional challenge question, which we would encourage all pupils to think about and answer.

We recommend your child reads for at least 20 minutes every day. Research suggests reading daily for this amount of time will lead to optimal development and will benefit your child across all subjects in the curriculum.

Home Learning Update

As previously, Home Learning will be sent to parents via email every Friday. However, the Home Learning will also be accessible on Google Classroom and not stuck in the children's books this year. Presently, **all of the children's work will be recorded in their Home Learning Books** as we make the transition of working in a new way at home in Years 1-6.

On Google Classroom, the Home Learning documents will look like the example below:
